

Introduction

This documents presents a revised budget proposal of a Writing Workshop to take place in Brazil as part of a set of activities leading to CSCW 2017 in Rio de Janeiro. Changes in this activity reflect the feedback from the SIGCHI Executive Committee. Because of approaching of the event in question, this document addresses only the Writing Workshop activity. The document describing the other activities will be presented separately later.

It is important to address the integration of this effort with the HCI and the larger Latin America community. It is noteworthy that the proposed writing workshop will take place prior to the Brazilian Symposium in Collaborative Systems and the Brazilian Human Factors in Computing Systems Symposium which in turn will be collocated (<http://www.ihc2015.unifacs.br/index.php/en/>). As such, this will be a unique opportunity for both communities to gain a clearer understanding of the SIGCHI conferences, submission process, and writing “requirements.” We engaged the HCI Steering Committee members in Brazil who saw the value of the workshop as well as the CSCW 2017 conference. Similarly, we will bring Latin America researchers to participate in the workshop so that they can help disseminate information about the SIGCHI conferences, submission process.

Writing Workshop

- **Description:** 1-day workshop during the Brazilian Symposium on Collaborative Systems and the Brazilian Human Factors in Computing Systems Symposium.
- **Goals:** To significantly increase the quality of submissions from Latin American and Brazilian research groups to ACM conferences. Specifically, coach submitters to CSCW, CHI, DIS, and other SIGCHI conferences.
- **How:** 1-day workshop lead by international researchers indicated by ACM SIGCHI
- **When:** November 2015 (<http://www.ihc2015.unifacs.br/index.php/en/>)
- **Cost:**
 1. Small set of experienced researchers to present and act as coaches during the workshop (involves preparation plus trip to Brazil). To reduce costs, we plan to have David Millen from IBM Research, who is currently in Brazil, as one of the presenters;
 2. Small set of Latin American HCI and CSCW researchers to attend the workshop to help in the dissemination of the information;
 3. Chair(s) to organize this workshop, oversee logistics, work through review process of submitters. The chair will have the support of the workshop organizers; and
 4. Financial support as described below.
